What are the school hours?

The school hours are 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for grades K-8 and 8:00-3:10 p.m. for grades 9-12.

What is the student to teacher ratio?

The student to teacher ratio is 14:1.

What is the teacher retention rate?

91% of teachers were retained in 2020.

How many employees work at Eagle Ridge Academy?

Eagle Ridge Academy employs 181 people.

How many students are enrolled at Eagle Ridge Academy?

There are 1430 students in grades K-12: 826 in the School of Grammar (grades K-5), 361 in the School of Logic (grades 6-8), and 245 in the School of Rhetoric (grades 9-12).

Enrollment Information

- Applications are accepted from October 1, 2021 through January 15, 2022. They will be entered into the enrollment lottery on January 18, 2022.
- Applications received after January 15, 2022 will not be included in the lottery. The applications will be processed and added to the bottom of the wait lists in the order that they are received.
- Lottery results will be communicated via email on February 1, 2022.
- Preference is given to siblings of students that are currently attending Eagle Ridge Academy.
- Twins are not treated as 'siblings' until one becomes enrolled. At that time, the sibling twin will be moved to the bottom of the sibling wait list.
- 138 kindergarten spots are available each year and approximately 350 kindergarten applications will be received.
 - There were 368 kindergarten applications included in the 2020-2021 lottery.
 - Those offered enrollment on February 1, 2020 were 78 siblings, 1 faculty member's child, and 59 general applicants. The remainder of the applicants were waitlisted.
 - Since the initial offer in February, there have been 97 more kindergarten offers extended (the application that was waitlist #97 in February is now waitlist #1.)
- Openings in all other grades are determined by the number of students that do not return for the 2022-2023 school year.
- There will not be openings to fill in January at the time of the lottery. This is because the current 2021-2022 students will return for 2022-2023. Very few students do not return year to year in grades 1-6.
- Applicants in grades 1-6 will receive a waitlist number when the lottery notification is emailed out in February.
- It is usually in late spring or throughout the summer months before families begin to notify the school that they will not be returning for the 22-23 school year.
